



FINAL YEAR PROJECT

General Instructions for the Candidates:

- Participants must have their students ID card.
- Any damage to the Institute's property (tools, equipment etc.) will result in a penalty to be reimbursed by the participant.
- Incomplete forms shall not be entertained and accepted.
- Information given must be valid. In case of wrong information, SEE committee reserves the rights to cancel the participation of such teams on spot.
- Evaluators' decision will be final and cannot be challenged.
- SEE organizing committee reserves the right to change the rules without any prior notice.

Rules and Regulations:

- All projects should be either a combination of hardware or software.
- All projects should be solely be the FYP of the team as they will be a representation of their universities.
- Participants must also bring along poster(s) to aid their project's display. Posters should not be larger than 3 ft vertically and 2 ft horizontally.
- To be eligible for evaluation, the project must be in working condition.
- Keeping in mind the scope of an FYP, evaluation of projects will last two (2) days.
- At least one team member must be present at all times at the project display during evaluation.
- 6th and 7th semester projects may gain entry into this competition, if deemed to be technically up to the mark.
- All the teams are required to bring 'Project Report' of their project along with the hardware.
