## PLAN

### DAY 1: (ROUND 1)

#### “Quiz”

- This will be a MCQs based round, where participant will have to independently solve the quiz.
- Questions for this round will be based on IQ & General Knowledge.
- Participants will have thirty (90) minutes to complete this round.

### DAY 2: (ROUND 2)

#### “Oral”

- Questions for this round will vary from Physics and Chemistry.
- Participant will be asked six (6) questions in this round. In case of a wrong answer that question will be forwarded to the team sitting next to them (as a bonus question).

### DAY 2: (ROUND 3)

- Participant will be asked a total of eight (8) questions in this round.
- Question for this round will vary from World History and Mathematics.
- Each question has to be answered in a maximum of 75 seconds time duration.
- A wrong answer will result in negative marking.
