



SPELLING BEE

General Instructions for the Candidates:

- This competition comprises of 4 rounds.
 1. Easy
 2. Mediocre
 3. Hard
 4. Extremely Hard
- It is an individual level competition.
- Use of mobile phones and laptops are strictly prohibited during the competition. If found will be disqualified immediately.
- Participants must have their students ID card and they should be of school level.
- Any damage to the Institute's property (tools, equipment etc.) will result in a penalty to be reimbursed by the participant.
- Incomplete forms shall not be entertained and accepted.
- Information given must be valid. In case of wrong information, SEE committee reserves the rights to cancel the participation of such teams on spot.
- Evaluators' decision will be final and cannot be challenged.
- Each round shall result in elimination of participants.
- Participants must report 30 minutes before the start of competition. No extra time will be provided.
- Once out of the competition area, you will not be allowed to join again.
- SEE organizing committee reserves the right to change the rules without any prior notice.

Rules and Regulations:

- The pronouncer announces the word to be spelled. He speaks slowly and clearly, without distorting the normal pronunciation of the word.
- The speller listens carefully to the pronouncer and asks for the word to be repeated if necessary.
- When the speller is sure he/she understands the word, he/she pronounces it, spells it and then says the word again. She must say it loudly enough for the judge to hear it.
- The judge(s) determines whether or not the word was spelled correctly.
- If the correct spelling was given, the speller remains in the game.
- The elimination procedure changes when the number of contestants is reduced to two. At this point, when one contestant misspells a word, the other contestant will be given the opportunity to spell the same word.

- When there are only two spellers left, if one player misspells a word, the other player must spell that word correctly, plus one more word to be declared the winner of the spelling bee.
- If the second contestant spells the word correctly, plus the next word on the pronouncer's list, then he or she will be declared champion. If the contestant misspells the word on the pronouncer's list, then both spellers continue in the contest.
- If both contestants misspell the same word, then both continue in the contest.
- A list of words will be provided three (3) days before the competition.

PLAN:

DAY 1: (ROUND 1)

- This will be a MCQs based round, where the candidate will have to independently solve the quiz.
- Questions for this round will be asked from the handouts provided to candidates.
- Participants will have sixty (60) minutes to complete this round.
- Only 20 Contestant will be shortlisted for Day 2.

DAY 2: (ROUND 2)

- Qualifiers of Round I will be allowed to compete in this round.
- This will be an Oral based round, where the contestant has to spell and pronounce the spelling of the word correctly.
